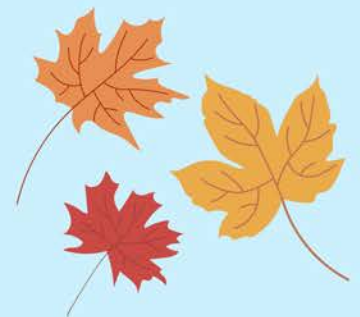

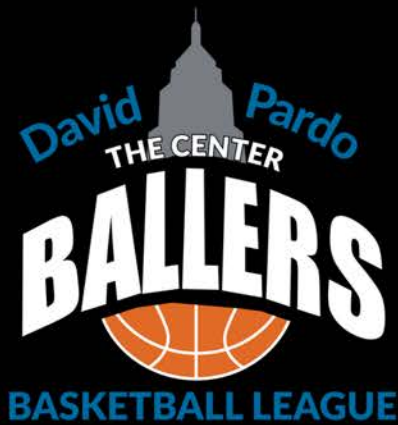

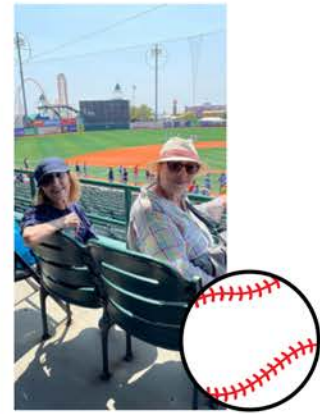


SENIOR CENTER
